THE VIEW FROM HERE

I know we're not supposed to have favorites, but I do. Philippians is one of my favorite books in the whole Bible, and I'm excited that we are spending 4 weeks in July diving into this book together in worship. I hope that you'll take advantage of the simple reading plan that will be available both in bulletins and online to read through this amazing letter from Paul. Join us in worship in person starting July 9, or online if you are travelling, as many of us will be doing this summer.

I love how the letter begins, as Paul offers grace and peace to his sisters and brothers, along with this prayer:

"I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." Philippians 1:3-6

You may know that your pastor is incredibly mushy, but that prayer has special significance for me as I write this. July 1 marks a milestone for me in ministry, as I will begin my 30th year in vocational ministry.

July 1994, Dover Bethany United Methodist Church near York took a chance on a seminary student, and hired me to serve as their Youth Director, overseeing a junior high and a senior high school group. In some ways, the rest is history.

But it's also a milestone, because on July 1, I begin my 10th year in ministry with you at Faith Church. The bishop and the church took a chance on me when I was first appointed here in 2010 with no large church experience, a two-year-old, and a lot more hair. In that first six years, God was faithful as we launched a 3rd service, grew in almost every area of ministry, and made plans for a facility expansion that would help us connect, grow, serve and go in new ways. Then, in 2020, the bishop took a chance on appointing me here again – something that almost never happens in the United Methodist Church. In the last 3 years, God has been faithful as we navigated COVID, launched worship in the FCC, and seen ministries continue to adapt and change in order to be faithful in this day – building on the faithful ministry and vision that you and Pastor Jake followed in completing construction, establishing Harvest of Hope and seeking to become deeply devoted followers of Jesus who make God's kingdom real.

As I start Year 30, and as we begin Year 10 together, I go back to Philippians 1:9-11,

And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

Canned Vegetables (Corn, green beans, baked beans, peas, etc. 15 oz.)


