I offer them here for two reasons: 1) Just a reminder that participating in community groups is, I think, one of the most important practices in becoming a deeply devoted follower of Jesus who connect, grow, serve and go, and 2) Reflecting on these questions will prepare each of our hearts for some of our Fall sermon series.

- Made for Mondays working to connect what we do on Sundays to what we do the rest of the week.
- The Micah Project What does it mean to act justly, love mercy and walk humbly with God?
- Paper Walls moving beyond the excuses that hold us back.

Each question focuses on a word:

- Start What do I need to start doing to move in the direction of the life story I want to tell?
- Stop What can you stop in order to move you closer to God's divine direction?
- Stay Am I choosing to give up because it's the right thing or because it seems like leaving would be easier?
- Go What is God calling me to leave? Where is He calling me to go?
- Serve God, how are You calling me to serve? Who are You calling me to serve? Where are You calling me to serve?
- Connect What do I need to do to connect with the right people?
- Trust Will we trust that God is good even when life is not?

I'm looking forward to continuing to journey together into this next season, and I hope that you will join us as we connect, grow, serve and go as part of this amazing community of Faith Church.

Jessica is our new part-time Director of Children's Ministries. Jessica will provide primary leadership for our ministries with and for children from birth through 5<sup>th</sup> grade and their families. Specifically, Jessica will focus on Kid Connection and Nursery Care, as well as provide staff support for special events like Vacation Bible School and Easter Jam.

Having a Masters in Social Work, Jessica brings a wonderful spirit to this ministry. Prior to moving back to Pennsylvania with Mason and their children, Jessica served on staff at The Gathering Church as their Children and Youth Director. In that role, Jessica led (pre-COVID) a ministry that reached 60-70 children and 30 students. Her ministry included recruiting, training and supporting teachers, working with the larger leadership to build connections across generations, and helping that congregation navigate the COVID season while offering ministry primarily online to those age groups – no easy task. If you were at our Ash Wednesday service, you'll have heard Jessica preach already, and will have heard her heart. Jessica's passion is to set a place at the table for all of God's children, where we can meet Jesus together, and be formed into the image of Christ together – no matter our age.

ORANGE SPOTLIGHT

This September our kids will seek wisdom from the Bible and focus on what it really means to trust God in all circumstances. Our elementary age children will be learning important lessons about friendship and what it means that God created us to be in relationship with others. They'll hear about David and Jonathan, Paul and Barnabas, the power of forgiveness and more! Meanwhile, our preschool age children will focus on the basic truth that God knows what is best for us and helps us make good choices. They will be opening God's true Word and discovering people like Jonah, Namaan, and Moses who had to choose whether or not they would trust God and follow His leading. Thank you for sharing your kids with us as we explore the Bible together and discover the priceless treasures God's Word contains!




## WOMEN'S GATHERING
