At Faith Church, we are led by two primary teams. One of those teams are our staff and ministry leaders, part-time, full-time and volunteer, who focus on day-to-day ministries and equipping us all for the work to which God calls us.

### A NEW RELATIONSHIP FOR A NEW YEAR

As was shared in worship in November, Faith Church will be connected with Bethel UMC Montoursville as of January 1, 2025 in a new relationship called a two-point charge. What that means is, starting in the new year, Pastors Larry and Marion will both be appointed to continue serving Faith Church as we have been, but will also be serving the congregation at Bethel UMC on the corner of Spruce and Montour Streets. Logistically, this will mean some minor adjustments to each of our pastors' time usage and scheduling, as we begin to shepherd the 35+ folks who call Bethel Church home. On Sundays, whoever preaches for worship here at Faith will leave after our 9:45 to lead worship at 11:00 a.m. at Bethel. In addition, Pastor Marion will help provide congregational care, and Pastor Larry will provide administrative support. While there may be opportunities in the future for shared ministries – for instance, studies that include folks from both congregations – for the most part, neither congregation will see much different in the way that their churches function. We trust God to continue



to bless and to make fruitful the gifts that our pastors and our congregations bring – all for the glory of Jesus!


