



The study combines scripture and words and lyrics from the inimitable Johnny Cash in ways that have led to some great discussion about grace, forgiveness, character and ambition.

I confess I'd never heard of the song from which this quote originated. It was from an album of duets with Waylon Jennings, another country superstar, titled <u>Heroes</u>. But the lyrics struck me, and I wanted

to share them with you.

I need to be reminded of those lyrics on a regular basis. As Johnny and Waylon describe in the song, there's a lot of troubling stuff going on around us. The reality of living in a broken world that awaits the full restoration of the promise of Jesus in the kingdom of God means that we live with a lot of unknowing. Whether it's our interpersonal relationships, the economy, questions within the larger Church, and another ugly election cycle, there's a lot about which I am uncertain.

But here's what I know that I know that I know:

- Life is the answer. Jesus is God's answer to the troubling, "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." (John 10:10)
- **God is the reason**. I Peter 3:15 reminds us of our reason, "But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have."
- **Love is the way.** Jesus told us the bottom line of what it means to follow him in John 13:35, " By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

One of the million things I love about Faith Church is that we realize that life is messy and people are messy and the Church is messy and the world is messy. AND we hold onto the Truth that God is good and grace abounds and Jesus is on the throne and life is breaking through all around us.

Whether it's Starting the Party with Vacation Bible Schoolers, traveling to West Virginia to bless and be blessed by neighbors in the Appalachia Service Project, restocking the shelves of Harvest of Hope to set us up for a new school year of sharing with our neighbors through the backpack program, joining in conversations about what it means to be the Church or to fund ministry, or any of the dozens of other ways you will do it, I'm grateful to be with you on the journey.
