Orange Spotlight: Kid Connection uses Orange Curriculum to partner with churches and families in creating community around a timeless message that mobilizes the next generation to love God and serve others.

Preschool: Jesus wants everyone on His team! Jesus wants everyone everywhere to follow Him (Matthew 9: 9-12 & Like 5:1-11) and be His friend forever. One of the incredible mysteries we embrace as people of faith is that the God of the universe knows us each by name and loves us with an everlasting, unfailing love. He already knows our every need but still invites us to pray. In the words of Thabiti Anyabwile, a pastor in Washington, DC, "But real prayer is an expression of love...Because in prayer we're communing with God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit. We're praying to the Father in the name of the Son through the Spirit. And in the act of prayer, we're meant to enjoy them and to know them." He also wrote, "Even when we can't trace God's hand, as the saying goes, we can trust his heart because we know God is good, and we're grateful for his goodness." Each one of us can draw close to God through prayer. In addition, as a community of faith we can help care for those around us by walking alongside those whose trust in His

goodness is shaken by difficult circumstances. We are called to encourage one another and, as much as possible, to help one another see the God given good, beauty, truth, and light through the threatening darkness.

I am constantly encouraged as I hear about folks quietly and consistently caring for friends, neighbors, and folks within our congregation without fanfare simply because it is within their ability to help. In addition to the informal support we regularly offer one another, Faith Church has a congregational care team made up of church staff and incredible volunteers that exists to meet the needs of the congregation. Our Congregational Care Team serves by praying with and for you and those you love, mailing cards to folks recovering from illness or grieving losses, visiting with people in hospitals and nursing homes, delivering meals through Casserole Ministry, bringing home communion to our homebound members and more. 
YOUNG ADULT COMMUNITY GROUP
