THE VIEW FROM HERE

In March of 2020, as the world shut down due to the COVID pandemic, I began a practice of beginning each day with praise and ending each day with gratitude. In a chaotic season where the three people in our household were trying to attend sixth grade, teach fourth grade, and oversee 75 pastors and 115 churches – all while preparing to move to Montoursville and begin our ministry here, I knew that my own struggles with anxiety and depression were going to be heightened.

I knew that, with so much uncertainty and so much beyond my control, one thing I could do was to choose to find something to praise God for and something to thank God for each day. It was a spiritual practice or discipline for me that I hoped would shape my heart toward joy and hope, rather than fear and despair. And so I posted my praise and my gratitude on Facebook (because I'm such a social media influencer!). Some days it was easy to find fodder for the thankful posts. Other days, the thing for which I was most thankful was that the day was over.

Now, three and a half years later, I'm still engaging the practice. The pandemic has passed. It's usually much easier to find things to be grateful for at the end of each day. There are still rough days (and weeks, and maybe even a month or two), but the intentional practices of finding a point of praise and a place of thanksgiving each day helps even them out.

In November, we tend to focus a great deal on thanksgiving. I'm OK with that – my favorite meal is the full Thanksgiving spread we share with our families each year, especially the stuffing! I want to encourage each of us, though, to develop a daily practice of gratitude. This isn't about ignoring the hard things in life (I voice those quite a bit myself), or putting on a happy face (I often display resting grump face myself). It's about seeking out those glimpses of God's goodness both on those days when it seems too many to count, and on those days when it takes you fifteen minutes to think of one.

How will you develop the discipline of gratitude this month, and beyond?


