COUNCIL

In talking with folks in a variety of settings, when they find out I am a pastor, they will often say something like, "I have a question." What follows often gives voice to something they value, they hope, or they don't understand. Some I've heard are:

"If God made everything, who made God?"

"What happens when the cancer comes back?"

"What is going on in the world?"

When we invited you to share your thoughts on sermon series that may be meaningful, many of you shared your responses in the form of a question.

"Why does God allow suffering?"

"How does a married couple navigate when there are differences

in spiritual matters, politics and money?"

"How do you approach someone who has lost their faith?"

As we met for this year's Worship Design Team Retreat, the staff and members of the church who prayed through this process felt strongly that God was calling us to lay some foundation – not just over a series or two, but over the next several years – that will help us all grow in our answering of what we understand to be the four most important questions.

"Who is God?"
"Who am I?"
"What is the gospel?"
"Who are we?"

These questions guide how we understand and, we think, formulate answers for many of the other big questions that life throws at us. While we will look at how scripture answers these questions in a variety of ways over the next two years, we will start this journey with a series we're calling Big Questions starting September 8. I hope that you'll not only commit to being here those four Sundays, but that you'll invite someone who may be wrestling with some of their own questions to join us.

Church Council Nominations

Our Church Council, made up of 9 members elected for up to two consecutive three-year terms exists to ensure the vision of helping people connect in worship, grow in community groups, serve the body of Christ and go into the world to make disciples of Jesus. The Church Council at Faith Church focuses their work in three areas (Staffing, Facilities and Finance) including:

Approve the Annual Budget.

Approve the hiring of any member of the Leadership Team.

Annually review the Lead Pastor in conjunction with the District Superintendent.

Approve all land acquisitions, facility construction and significant legal obligations.

When a special need exists, the Council can create a task force consisting of a sub-group of the board and/or other church members. This would include the election of new members to the Church Council.

Actively pursue learning opportunities as it relates to large church structure and development. This could include books, conferences and other learning tools.

Folks that serve on the Church Council should possess the following character traits:

Compassion (love for Jesus, his people, and his mission).

Competency (skills consistent with human resources, operations and stewardship).

Creativity (ability to look at the total of God's resources and bring the best into the church).

Leadership matters, especially as we navigate these days in the life of the Church. The Nominations Committee will be prayerful discerning two people to serve on the Church Council, beginning in 2025. Please prayerfully consider whether this is a calling God may be placing on you. If you are interested in being considered for nomination please e-mail Pastor Larry ASAP. Pastor Larry and the Nominations Committee will meet with potential nominees in September, before presenting nominees to this year's Charge Conference, on Sunday, November 10 at 6:00 p.m.

This annual business and vision meeting for the congregation completes important business for the church, including setting the pastor's salary package, electing officers for the coming year and other yearly tasks. 
Kid Connection: During the 9:45 service, Infant through 5th grade join in the mission of the church making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world where all are invited to become an apprentice to Jesus with age appropriate, hands-on learning.

Nursery (Birth through 2 years) During the 9:45 service children will be encouraged to play, and build friendships with others! After the worship set Diane Dunlap will present a short Bible story and an invitation to a coloring page related to the story.

Preschool: (3-5 year old class) This month, we're talking about THE light that God sent into the world to shine bright for all the world to see. And THIS light has a name. His name is Jesus! Each time we choose to love like Jesus, we become a bright light. Just like each LiteBrite peg lights up to make a picture, each and every act of love is a bright light that makes a beautiful picture for the world to see Jesus.

K-4th Grade: The foundation of our Christian spiritual formation is asking these questions, "Who is God"? In September, Kid Connection will be learning how God is compassionate! As we learn to know God through Jesus, we too can reflect God's light showing compassion to others and we can LIVE BRIGHT!



A LETTER FROM MARYBETH

Dear Church Family,

My name is Marybeth Croll. I teach 3rd grade Kid Connection and attend the 9:45 service. I have a husband who's a physician, Scott, and a daughter, Abby, who's a Vet Tech in Pittsburgh. My mother, Jane, lives with us. I volunteer at Divine Hospital and Sojourner Truth Ministries House of Hope. I love getting together for coffee talk with my girlfriends and doing crafts.

I'm reaching out to you all because I have Stage 4 renal failure and am currently on the transplant list. I am looking for a living donor kidney between 18-75 years of age in good health. My doctors want me on the transplant list because, without a kidney, I may need dialysis. I have been in stage 4 renal failure for several years, but recently my kidney numbers have declined.

I'm very independent and would like to stay that way, so I'm turning to you for support and to spread the word to find a living donor, so I can receive a life-saving transplant. I would truly appreciate it if you shared my story with others.
